This Indenture made this the 3^d day of August in the year
of Our Lord one thousand seven hundred & eighty seven between Zachariah
Harmon former Sheriff of Chatham County in the State of North Carolina
of the one part & Elizabeth Sasser of the County & State aforesaid of the
other part Whereby the said Zachariah Harmon by a writ commonly
called a Fieri Facias Issued from the County Court of Chatham was command-
ed as follows (to wit) State of North Carolina to the Sheriff of Chatham
County Greeting Ye are hereby commanded that of the Goods & Chattels
Lands & Tenements of Nancy Hogan Administratrix of Sarah Hogan
deceased you cause to be made the sum of Twenty eight pounds six shillings
and eight pence which lately in our County Court of pleas and Quarter Sessi-
ons Benjamin Clements recovered against her as Administratrix for debt
as also three pounds eighteen shillings & nine pence the Money for Costs
and Charges in said Suit expended whereof the said Nancy Hogan Admini-
stratrix of said deceased is convicted and liable as appears of record and
have you the said Money before the said Court at Chatham on the se-
cond Monday in May next then and their to render to the said Benjamin
Clements his debt and Costs aforesaid herein fail not and have you their
this writ Witness John Ramsey Clerk of our said Court at office the
10th day of February Anno. Dom. 1786 and in the Ninth year of Our
Independence

and the said Zachariah Harmon by virtue of the aforesaid writ and in
pursuance of an Act of General Assembly Intituled an Act for establish-
ing Courts of Law and regulating the Proceedings therein passed at
New Bern in the year of one thousand seven hundred & seventy seven
wherein it is called that by policy and genius of our present Consti-
tion Lands and Tenements ought to be Subject to the Payment of Just debts
when the Debtor not having Good & Chattels Lands & Tenements shall for
the future Issue in the same manner and Manner as if said good & Chattels
only shall hereafter Issue against Lands and Tenements as well as good
and Chattels and the Sheriff upon such Execution shall proceed to Seize the
same upon the Goods and Chattels in the first Instance if any thereof but
