Cross Creek in the County of Cumberland and province of North Carolina March:  
and John Stevens and Sarah his wife of the other part Witnesseth that the said John  
Stevens and Sarah his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of Twenty pounds  
pecuniary money of North Carolina to him in hand paid by the said Mitchell  
at first before the sealing and Delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof  
they the said John Stevens & Sarah his wife both hereby acknowledge themselves  
to be there with fully satisfied and paid both granted Bargained and sold Alined  
confirmed and by these presents both grant Bargain sell Alined and Consumed  
unto the D. Mitchell Carol a certain piece or parcel of Land containing five  
acres more or less lying in said County Near Cross Creek by the old Oak  
and beginning at the upper Corner of Lewis Berge at a black Sack and  
running along Mark Cole line to the middle of the branch then Down the  
middle of the branch to a small gum in Cochran line then to a stump in  
Cochran Corner Called willow mallet Corner then to a Light wood stump  
in Simpson line then Direct to the beginning and being part of Two surveys  
one well known and one Joseph Thibaults granted by the Kings Letter  
patents to have and to hold the afore said Land and premises and every  
part and parcel thereof which D. John Stevens and Sarah his wife granted  
to D. Mitchell Carol the D. piece of Land his heirs and assigns shall be  
way at all times hereafter have had and Enjoy the afore D. premises with the
