 and State aforesaid, Hiram Hardin, aged
 sixty years, a resident of Monroe County
 in the State of Alabama, who being
 duly sworn, according to law, declares
 that he is the identical Hiram Hardin
 who was a private in the company
 commanded by Captain Wolly in
 eighth Regiment of Infantry, com-
 manded by Col Jack (a Lieut Col
 Manning) in the war with Great Brit-
 ain declared by the U.S. 15th June 1812;
 that he enlisted in said war at Pendleton
 District, S.C. on or about the first day
 of May A.D. 1813 for and during the war;
 that he was mustered into the U.S. ser-
 vice soon after at Fort Hawkins, Georgia
 having enlisted under Lieut Hunter; that
 he continued in actual service in said
 war for about two years, & was honorably
 discharged at Ft Hawkins, Ga on or about
 May 1, 1815, as will appear by the muster
 rolls of said company. He further declares
 that he has lost his written discharge. He
 makes this declaration for the purpose of
 obtaining the bounty land to which he may be
 entitled under the act passed Sept 28th 1850
